## Respond to one of the following prompts:

- 1. Think of a question about *The Sarvatathāgatādhiṣṭhānasattvāvalokanabuddhakṣetra-saṃdarśanavyūha Sūtra*. Answer that question. You will be graded on the quality of your question as well as your answer.
  - Make sure that you cite the sūtra in your analysis.
- 2. Think of a question about Mahāyāna Buddhism. Answer that question. You will be graded on the quality of your question as well as your answer.
  - Make sure that you cite one or more sūtras in your analysis.

Your paper should be no shorter than 500 words (about two pages).
